Check for so-called 'double-extended' scam attachments. A text file named 'safe tyt' is safe, but a file called 'safe.txt.exe' is not.



www.support.microsoft.software.com are two different domains. (and only the first is real)



open any email attachments that end with: .exe, .scr, .bat, .com, or other executable files you do not recognize.

**DONOT** "unsubscribe" - it is easier to delete the e-mail than to deal with the security risks.



ever click embedded links in messages without hovering your mouse over them first to check the URL.
